Participants will receive:

- Employability and job readiness training
- Transportation support, where available
- Assistance securing a paid work placement for up to 12 weeks
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)

Eligibility:

Applicants must:

- Be women or gender-diverse individuals aged 18 or older
- Live in Ontario and be legally entitled to work in Ontario
- Have completed Grade 12 or an equivalent level of education (proof of at least 16–18 high school credits required)
- Be able to travel to training and work sites
